## **Explanation of Events:**

### **Monday Crafts; 10:00 am – 11:30 am:**

Open to the public and free of charge. All ages welcomed. There are four separate crafts at four tables. You are welcomed to visit each table and take home the craft you make! This year's theme is Be Creative ... and we've incorporated lots of painting, mosaics, weaving and music into our crafts!

### **Tuesday: Story time or Programs, 10:30 am to 11:00 or 11:30 am:**

Open to the public and free of charge. Story times run 30 to 40 minutes. Programs run approximately a full hour. All ages are welcomed, however, ages 3 to 7 will have the most fun! Programs, from Snakes, to our Native American Storyteller, to the Storm Chasers, will delight all ages; including moms and dads!

### **Wednesday: Workshops, 10:30 am; or Movie Days, 1:30 pm; Evening Story times, 6:30 pm.**

All events are open to the public and free of charge. Evening story times include a craft. Workshops alternate with Movie Days. See the calendar for specific information. Movies will be family oriented and will have a tie-in to a book. Possible titles include *The Tale of Despereaux*, Disney Movies (*Jungle Book*, *Peter Pan*, or *Pocahontas* - examples only), *Where the Red Fern Grows* and more. Workshops include learning to crochet a bookmark, building a model, and a scrapbooking project.

### **Thursday: Baby Mozart Club, 10:00 am; Creative Writing and Movie Making.**

The Baby Mozart Club is a mommy and me (or grandma, or daddy, or ?) session for newborns up to 3 years. This program is open to the public and free of charge. Our youngest patrons will enjoy music, puppets, shapes, colors, size, finger and hand games and play time.

The Creative Writing and Movie Making workshops are designed to help those who have purchased the Book Publishing Kit. Times for these workshops are listed on the calendar. This activity is open to kids of all ages (although young ones will need help!) and costs \$8.95. The final product is a delightful hard bound book exhibiting your child's story and illustrations.
